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01 Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how Cleanfinity Limited uses cookies and similar technologies on this website. It should be read alongside our Privacy Policy .

We use cookies in accordance with the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR) and the UK General Data Protection Regulation.

02 The short version

When you first visit, we ask whether you accept cookies. If you decline, nothing non-essential is stored and the site works exactly the same. If you accept, we can see which pages are useful and whether our advertising is working. You can change your answer at any time using Cookie settings in the footer.

03 What cookies are

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help sites work properly and can tell the site owner how the site is being used.

04 Strictly necessary cookies

These are needed for the site to function and are set without consent, as PECR allows. They support secure access, submitting a form, page navigation, load balancing and fraud prevention.

We also store your cookie choice itself, so we are not asking you the same question on every page. That preference is kept for six months, after which we ask again.

05 Analytics cookies

If you accept, we use Google Analytics 4 to understand how the website is being used.

Nothing is set until you accept. If you decline, Google's tag runs in a restricted mode that sets no cookies and cannot identify you.

06 Advertising cookies

If you accept, we may use Google Ads and Meta (Facebook and Instagram) advertising tools.

If you decline, these tools are not loaded at all — not restricted, not present.

07 Third parties

Our website is hosted by Netlify, which may set strictly necessary cookies for security and load balancing. Where you have accepted, Google and Meta set the cookies described above under their own privacy terms.

08 Changing your mind

You can change or withdraw consent at any time.

- Use Cookie settings , in the footer of every page
- Or clear cookies for this site in your browser, which resets the question

Withdrawing consent is as easy as giving it, and we ask again every six months regardless.

09 Browser controls

Most browsers let you delete cookies, block them, or warn you before one is stored. Blocking strictly necessary cookies may stop parts of the site, such as the contact form, from working.

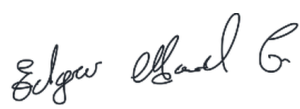
10 Updates to this policy
